Georgia Educational Standards Addressed: QCC Discuss what makes them feel patriotic.

Teacher Materials Needed: Book: *Casey and the Amazing Giant Green Shirt*

Student Materials Needed: Uncle Sam hat and U.S. flag, paper, crayons, pencils

Steps Information: Students will describe what makes them feel patriotic. Length of lesson is 30 minutes
Number of sessions 1.

Verification: Teacher observation and student responses during discussion. Observe student reactions and responses and ask appropriate question. Ex. What makes you feel patriotic and proud of your country? Did the students demonstrate understanding in their answers to the questions?

Activity: Read the book God Bless America. Then TSW discuss things that make them feel patriotic. TTW ask for some volunteers to come wear the Uncle Sam hat and wave an American flag. Teacher will discuss different ways some of us feel patriotic. (Singing patriotic songs, saying the Pledge, singing the anthem, waving flags, seeing the beautiful country we live in, etc.) Students will write and illustrate what makes them feel patriotic.

Other resource: Book-God Bless America by Irving Berlin illustrations by Lynn Munsinger

Summary/Assessment: Students realized what makes us feel proud about our country. Students with special needs will complete the given lesson with the following modifications as needed: One-on-one assistance with paraprofessional.

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
