Teacher Materials Needed: Book: *Casey and the Amazing Good Finder*

Student Materials Needed: Stars with positive words on them

Steps Information: Students will sit during good morning activities. Staff will read a section of the story to the students. Staff will ask students questions about the story. Staff will lead a discussion later in the day about positive words and why positive words will brighten someone’s day. Staff will show students various stars with positive words on them. Students and staff will discuss the various words. Students will choose 2 stars that they would want to give to someone. Then they will give the stars to that person.

Teacher Tips: Staff will read a section of the story each day over a week’s time. Staff will ask the students questions about the story.

Student Tips: Students will need to listen as the story is read to them. Students will choose a star that they would want to give to either an adult or another student.

Verification: Did the students listen to the story and answer questions about the story? Did the students choose stars to give to another person?

Activity: Students will take the star and give it to another adult or student. The person will wear the star around their neck. The student will also wear a star given to them by their classroom staff.

Other resource: Book, stars with positive words on them, star necklaces

Summary/Assessment: The staff and students will bake & decorate Halloween cookies. The students will give the cafeteria ladies a star necklace and some cookies in appreciation for all that they do for our class.
