Georgia Educational Standards Addressed: The "Casey Catch" lesson emphasizes speaking and listening skills across the curriculum, both in and out of the classroom.

Teacher Materials Needed: Book: *Casey and the Amazing Good Finder*

Student Materials Needed: Paper, pencil

Steps Information: 1. Copy one "Casey Catch" card per student. 2. Have students put name and number on card. 3. Role-play positive words versus contrived comments. 4. Provide every student with a teacher-created Good Finder message so that students understand the value of positive words. 5. Have students "catch" each other saying positive words and displaying positive actions over a three week period. 6. Students pass cards among entire team, signing initials as they pass. 7. Have students return "Casey Catch" cards to original owner's mailbox by the deadline. 8. Discuss the route of cards and the effects of those words and actions.

Teacher Tips: Role-play genuine versus contrived positive words. Add positive actions to the "Casey Catch" cards. Copy profiles for a variety of people. Discuss positive versus negative words and actions.

Student Tips: Be sure all 80 students write their name and student numbers on their cards in order to return the cards after week three. Allow students to choose person they'd like to study.

Verification: Conduct weekly progress checks. Have students discuss where their cards have traveled and what they have seen.

Activity: Compare and contrast the actions of famous people: Abraham Lincoln, Martin Luther King Jr., Adolf Hitler, Nelson Mandella, Florence Nightengale, etc.

Other resource: Web biographies

Summary/Assessment: Rewrite history: Adolf Hitler had been influenced by Abraham Lincoln. Adolf Hitler had become allies with Joseph Stalin. How do we influence each other? Connect "Casey Catch" with world history.
